I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST

All the major rivers are flowing below low flood level.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES

- a) Yesterday's low-pressure area over north Madhya Pradesh has become insignificant for the country.
- b) Moist currents are cut off from both sources.

Mainly dry weather is expected over the most parts of the country.
